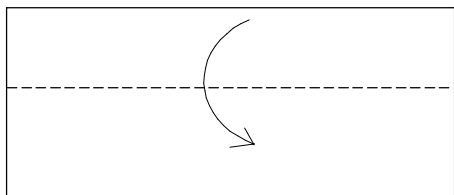


\$ Chopstick Wrapper

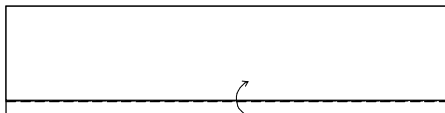

Inspired by chopstick wrapper discussion in origami-L mailing list.

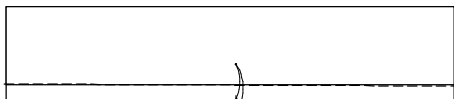
1. Start from 3x7 rectangle or US dollar bill; Washington face down is my preference if from US dollar bill; Leave a gap between upper edge and lower edge. The gap is about the same as border width of dollar bill.

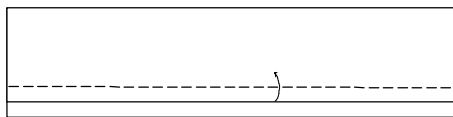
3. Fold and unfold



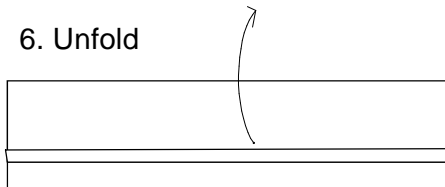
4. Unfold



5. top layer only along existing crease



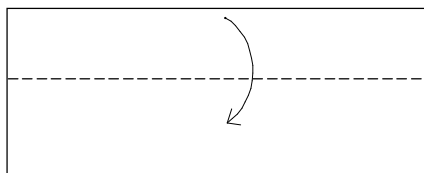
6. Unfold



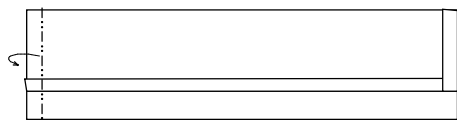

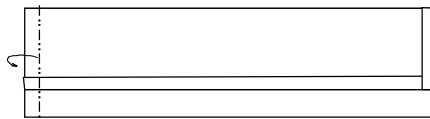
8. Fold along existing crease



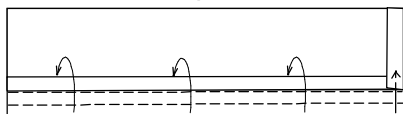
9. Mountain fold
